PENGENALAN

Rabies ialah masalah kesihatan awam yang serius di lebih 150 negara dan wilayah, terutamanya di Asia dan Afrika. Ia adalah penyakit tropika virus, zoonosis, terabai yang menyebabkan berpuluh-puluh ribu kematian setiap tahun, dengan 40% adalah kanak-kanak di bawah umur 15 tahun.

Gigitan dan calar anjing menyebabkan 99% daripada kes rabies manusia, dan boleh dicegah melalui vaksinasi anjing dan pencegahan gigitan.

Sebaik sahaja virus menjangkiti sistem saraf pusat dan gejala klinikal muncul, rabies membawa maut dalam 100% kes.

Walau bagaimanapun, kematian rabies boleh dicegah dengan profilaksis pasca pendedahan segera (PEP) dengan menghentikan virus daripada mencapai sistem saraf pusat. PEP terdiri daripada mencuci luka secara menyeluruh, pemberian kursus vaksin rabies manusia dan, apabila ditunjukkan, imunoglobulin rabies (RIG).



DAN FAHAM RABIES

Jika seseorang digigit atau dicakar oleh haiwan yang berpotensi gila, mereka harus segera dan sentiasa mendapatkan penjagaan PEP.

WHO dan rakan kongsi globalnya menyasarkan untuk menamatkan kematian manusia akibat rabies yang dikendalikan oleh anjing melalui pendekatan One Health yang komprehensif yang mempromosikan vaksinasi anjing besar-besaran, memastikan akses kepada PEP, latihan pekerja kesihatan, pengawasan yang lebih baik dan pencegahan gigitan melalui kesedaran masyarakat.



KRONOLOGI KES RABIES DI SARAWAK

Since the rabies outbreak was declared in 2017, we have faced a significant public health challenge. A total of 87 human rabies cases have been reported, tragically resulting in 80 fatalities as of October 2025. This year alone, we have lost six people to this preventable disease. All of these human deaths are the result of not being treated after being bitten, and it is only when symptoms appear that they receive medical attention. To ensure a coordinated and focused effort to eradicate rabies, four new divisions have been designated as rabies infected: Kuching, Samarahan, Kapit, and Bintulu. This declaration was required following the recent discovery of rabies-positive animals in these areas. In total, 29 areas in Sarawak remain officially designated as rabies infected areas. We can only declare Sarawak rabies-free after two years of no cases in humans or animals.



MAKLUMAT TERKINI DATA VAKSINASI

The main strategy for rabies control in Sarawak is mass dog vaccination, as dogs account for the vast majority of animal cases and serve as the primary reservoir. DVS Sarawak vaccinated 281,623 dogs between 2017 and 2025. In October 2025, the DVS and IBET teams vaccinated 33,318 dogs across Sarawak.

As of October 31st, 2025, 48 of 626 animal samples tested positive for rabies. The majority of animal rabies-positive cases were detected in eight districts and located in urban areas, with a high concentration in Kuching (14), Padawan (14), Bintulu (9), Bau (6), and Sebauh (2), followed by one (1) case each in Asajaya, Lundu, and Belaga. The vast majority of rabies-positive animals are owned pets that are not unvaccinated and roam freely. This year, there were 9% of animal rabies-positive cases, down from 13% in 2024.

Every pet owner of their legal and moral responsibility. You must immediately take action to ensure your dogs are licensed and vaccinated with the anti-rabies vaccine. Dog vaccination is mandatory under Section 40 of the Veterinary Public Health Ordinance 1999 (VPHO 1999). Additionally, please consider neutering your pets to help control the stray population. Let us work together. Compliance is not just a legal requirement; it is the most effective defence against this deadly disease.



SIMPTOM RABIES

Tempoh inkubasi untuk rabies biasanya 2-3 bulan tetapi mungkin berbeza dari satu minggu hingga satu tahun, bergantung kepada faktor seperti lokasi kemasukan virus dan viral load. Gejala awal rabies termasuk tanda-tanda generik seperti demam, sakit dan kesemutan yang luar biasa atau tidak dapat dijelaskan, dicucuk, atau sensasi terbakar di tapak luka. Apabila virus bergerak ke sistem saraf pusat, keradangan otak dan saraf tunjang yang progresif dan maut berkembang. Rabies klinikal pada orang boleh diuruskan tetapi sangat jarang disembuhkan, dan bukan tanpa defisit neurologi yang teruk.



SIMPTOM RABIES

Rabies yang marah mengakibatkan hiperaktif, tingkah laku yang mudah teruja, halusinasi, kekurangan koordinasi, hidrofobia (takut air) dan aerophobia (takut kepada draf atau udara segar). Kematian berlaku selepas beberapa hari akibat penangkapan kardio-pernafasan.

Rabies lumpuh menyumbang kira-kira 20% daripada jumlah kes manusia. Bentuk rabies ini berjalan kurang dramatik dan biasanya lebih lama daripada bentuk marah. Otot secara beransur-ansur menjadi lumpuh, bermula dari tapak luka. Koma perlahan-lahan berkembang dan akhirnya kematian berlaku. Bentuk lumpuh rabies sering salah didiagnosis, menyumbang kepada kurang pelaporan penyakit ini.



TANDA-TANDA KLINIKAL JANGKITAN RABIES

1. Tempoh inkubasi terhadap manusia :

- 6 bulan (90%) selepas terdedah.
- Tempoh 6 tahun juga dilaporkan.

2. Tempoh inkubasi dalam kucing dan anjing :

- 1 minggu sehingga 6 bulan tetapi lazimnya penyakit akan berkembang 1 atau 2 bulan setelah terdedah.

3. Semakin hampir jarak gigitan dengan kepala, maka semakin pendek tempoh inkubasi.

4. Tiga (3) fasa :

➤ *Prodromal*

- 2 hingga 3 hari & Demam
- Menjilat dan menggigit kawasan gigitan
- Perubahan tingkah laku
- Letih, gelisah & Muntah
- Lebih jinak dan manja
- Pupil mata melebar
- Tindak balas pupil menurun



➤ *Excitatory / Furious*

- Berlangsung selama 1 hingga 7 hari
- Mudah marah
- Cemas
- Hiperestesia
- Hipersalivasi
- Penyuaran
- Merayau - rayau
- Agresif
- Pica
- Ataxia, sawan, tanda vestibular, gegaran otot



➤ *Paralytic / Dumb*

- 1 hingga 10 hari setelah tanda klinikal pertama
- Kelumpuhan lembab
 - Lumpuh laring (perubahan suara)
 - Lumpuh faring (hipersalivasi)
 - Lumpuh otot muka (rahang jatuh)
- Koma dan mati akibat kegagalan jantung dan kegagalan sistem pernafasan



DIAGNOSIS RABIES

Pada masa ini tiada alat diagnostik yang diluluskan oleh WHO untuk mengesan jangkitan rabies sebelum permulaan penyakit klinikal.

Diagnosis klinikal rabies adalah sukar tanpa sejarah hubungan yang boleh dipercayai dengan haiwan rabies atau gejala khusus hidrofobia atau aerophobia. Penilaian risiko yang tepat adalah penting untuk membuat keputusan mengenai pentadbiran PEP.

Sebaik sahaja gejala muncul, dan kematian tidak dapat dielakkan, menawarkan penjagaan paliatif yang komprehensif dan penuh belas kasihan adalah disyorkan.

Pengesahan postmortem jangkitan rabies dilakukan dengan pelbagai teknik diagnostik yang mengesan keseluruhan virus, antigen virus, atau asid nukleik dalam tisu yang dijangkiti (otak, kulit atau air liur). Jika boleh, haiwan yang menggigit harus diuji.



LANGKAH-LANGKAH PENCEGAHAN

Pertama sekali, **vaksinasi haiwan peliharaan** adalah langkah paling penting dalam pencegahan rabies. Anjing dan kucing peliharaan harus divaksinasi secara berkala mengikut jadual yang ditetapkan oleh doktor haiwan. Vaksin rabies membantu membina imuniti terhadap virus dan melindungi haiwan peliharaan daripada jangkitan. Selain itu, vaksinasi juga mengurangkan risiko penularan virus kepada manusia, yang sering berlaku melalui gigitan atau cakaran haiwan yang dijangkiti.

Pengawasan haiwan peliharaan juga merupakan langkah kritikal dalam pencegahan rabies. Pemilik haiwan peliharaan harus memastikan bahawa anjing dan kucing mereka tidak berkeliaran di luar tanpa pengawasan. Haiwan peliharaan yang berkeliaran bebas berisiko untuk berinteraksi dengan haiwan liar yang mungkin terinfeksi rabies. Dengan mengawasi haiwan peliharaan, pemilik dapat mengurangkan kemungkinan haiwan mereka terdedah kepada virus rabies.



Mengelakkan haiwan liar adalah satu lagi langkah penting dalam pencegahan rabies. Haiwan liar seperti musang, kelawar, dan anjing liar mungkin pembawa virus rabies. Oleh itu, adalah penting untuk mengelakkan daripada bersentuhan langsung dengan haiwan liar. Jika terdapat haiwan liar yang menunjukkan tingkah laku tidak normal atau tanda-tanda rabies, ia harus segera dilaporkan kepada pihak berkuasa kawalan haiwan untuk tindakan lanjut.

Menutup celah di rumah juga membantu dalam pencegahan rabies. Haiwan liar boleh mencari tempat berlindung di dalam rumah melalui lubang atau celah yang ada. Menutup celah-celah ini boleh menghalang haiwan liar daripada masuk ke dalam rumah dan mengurangkan risiko jangkitan rabies.



Kesedaran dan pendidikan masyarakat memainkan peranan penting dalam pencegahan rabies. Kempen kesedaran mengenai bahaya rabies dan langkah-langkah pencegahannya harus dijalankan secara berterusan. Masyarakat perlu diberi maklumat yang tepat tentang pentingnya vaksinasi, cara-cara mengelakkan kontak dengan haiwan liar, dan tindakan yang perlu diambil sekiranya terdapat kes gigitan atau cakaran haiwan.



KESEDARAN TERHADAP RABIES

Pendidikan Awam dan Kesedaran Komuniti

Aspek utama dalam meningkatkan kesedaran tentang rabies adalah melalui program pendidikan awam. Kempen kesedaran perlu disebarluaskan melalui media cetak dan elektronik, ceramah umum, dan bahan pendidikan seperti brosur dan poster. Pendidikan awam harus fokus pada penyebaran maklumat mengenai cara penyebaran virus rabies, gejala awal yang perlu diwaspadai, dan langkah-langkah pencegahan yang boleh diambil. Dengan memberikan maklumat yang tepat dan komprehensif, masyarakat akan lebih memahami risiko dan tindakan yang perlu diambil untuk melindungi diri mereka dan haiwan peliharaan mereka.

Vaksinasi Haiwan Peliharaan

Vaksinasi haiwan peliharaan merupakan langkah paling kritikal dalam pencegahan rabies. Pemilik haiwan peliharaan harus memastikan bahawa anjing dan kucing mereka divaksinasi secara berkala mengikut jadual yang disarankan oleh doktor haiwan. Vaksinasi tidak hanya melindungi haiwan dari jangkitan, tetapi juga mencegah penularan virus rabies kepada manusia. Dengan memvaksinasi haiwan peliharaan, kita dapat memutuskan rantai penyebaran penyakit ini.

Pengawasan dan Penjagaan Haiwan Peliharaan

Selain vaksinasi, pengawasan yang ketat terhadap haiwan peliharaan juga penting. Pemilik harus menghindarkan haiwan mereka dari berkeliaran di luar tanpa pengawasan untuk mengelakkan interaksi dengan haiwan liar yang mungkin terinfeksi rabies. Penjagaan yang baik dan pengawasan yang teliti dapat mengurangkan risiko haiwan peliharaan terkena gigitan atau cakaran dari haiwan yang dijangkiti.

Kesedaran dan Pendidikan di Sekolah

Sekolah dan institusi pendidikan juga memainkan peranan penting dalam meningkatkan kesedaran tentang rabies. Melalui program pendidikan yang melibatkan pelajar, kita dapat menanam kesedaran tentang bahaya rabies dan langkah-langkah pencegahannya sejak usia muda. Program pendidikan ini boleh membantu membentuk generasi yang lebih bertanggungjawab dalam menjaga kesihatan diri dan masyarakat.



Penghindaran Kontak dengan Haiwan Liar

Masyarakat perlu diberi tahu tentang risiko rabies dari haiwan liar seperti musang, kelawar, dan anjing liar. Kontak langsung dengan haiwan liar harus dielakkan, dan jika terdapat haiwan liar yang menunjukkan tanda-tanda rabies, ia harus segera dilaporkan kepada pihak berkuasa kawalan haiwan. Langkah ini penting untuk mencegah penyebaran virus di kalangan populasi haiwan dan manusia.



VAKSIN RABIES UNTUK MANUSIA

Vaksin rabies untuk manusia adalah vaksin yang digunakan untuk mencegahjangkitan rabies. Rabies adalah penyakit virus yang serius dan hampir selalu membawa maut jika tidak dirawat sebelum gejala muncul. Vaksin rabies dapat digunakan dalam dua situasi utama: vaksinasi pra-pendedahan dan vaksinasi pasca-pendedahan.

Vaksinasi Pra-Pendedahan

Vaksinasi pra-pendedahan disarankan untuk individu yang berisiko tinggi terdedah kepada rabies, seperti pekerja haiwan, pelancong ke kawasan di mana rabies adalah endemik, dan individu yang bekerja dalam makmal dengan virus rabies. Vaksinasi ini membantu membina imuniti sebelum kemungkinan terdedah kepada virus.

Vaksinasi Pasca-Pendedahan

Vaksinasi pasca-pendedahan diberikan kepada individu yang telah digigit atau terdedah kepada air liur haiwan yang mungkin terinfeksi rabies. Vaksin ini mesti diberikan secepat mungkin selepas terdedah untuk mencegah virus dari menjangkiti sistem saraf pusat. Vaksinasi pasca-pendedahan biasanya melibatkan beberapa suntikan yang diberikan dalam tempoh beberapa minggu.

Pencegahan Penyakit yang Membawa Maut

Rabies hampir selalu membawa maut jika tidak dirawat sebelum gejala muncul. Vaksin rabies adalah cara yang paling berkesan untuk mencegah penyakit ini.

2

Perlindungan Imuniti

Vaksinasi membantu tubuh membina antibodi yang boleh melawan virus rabies jika seseorang terdedah kepadanya.

3

Keselamatan Masyarakat

Dengan lebih ramai orang yang divaksinasi, risiko penularan virus rabies dalam masyarakat dapat dikurangkan, melindungi individu lain dan haiwan peliharaan.

4

Pencegahan Penularan kepada Manusia Lain

Vaksinasi pasca-pendedahan adalah penting untuk mencegah virus daripada menjangkiti orang lain melalui gigitan atau cakaran haiwan yang terinfeksi.

TEMA: "ACT NOW: YOU, ME, COMMUNITY".

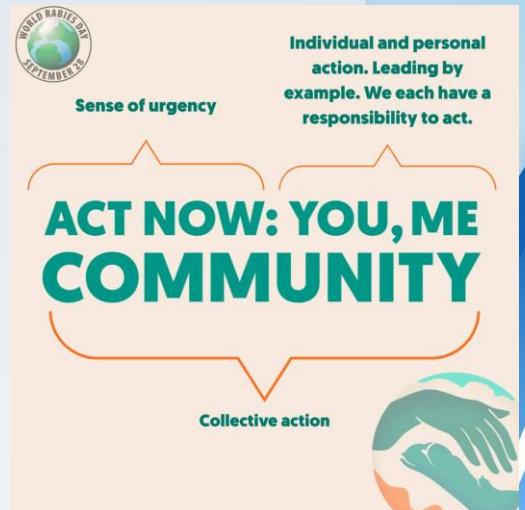
FOCUS: Tema ini menekankan bahawa penghapusan rabies adalah tanggungjawab bersama, yang memerlukan individu, komuniti dan organisasi bekerjasama.

YOU: Pemilikan haiwan peliharaan yang bertanggungjawab (memvaksin haiwan peliharaan), mendapatkan rawatan perubatan segera selepas kemungkinan terdedah.

ME: Memimpin melalui teladan, mendidik orang lain dan menyokong usaha penghapusan tempatan.

COMMUNITY: Menganjurkan pemacu vaksinasi, meningkatkan kesedaran dan memperkukuh sistem kesihatan tempatan.

GOAL: Matlamat utama adalah untuk mencapai sifar kematian manusia akibat rabies yang dikendalikan oleh anjing menjelang 2030, sasaran yang ditetapkan oleh World Health Organization (WHO), the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH), the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), dan the Global Alliance for Rabies Control (GARC).



Apa yang boleh anda lakukan?

Tema itu menyeru individu dan masyarakat bertindak untuk mencegah penularan rabies yang diperantarai oleh anjing. September 27, 2025 – DVS Sarawak & Local authorities successfully concluded two large-scale anti-rabies vaccination, licensing, and microchipping for dog programs today to observe World Rabies Day. The simultaneous events in Samarahan, Serian and Kuching resulted in 341 dogs being vaccinated, marking a significant stride in the region's efforts to control rabies. Dewan Serbaguna Kampung Semeba, Kuching, recorded the largest turnout. The Division of Veterinary Services Sarawak (DVSS) vaccinated 267 dogs belonging to 182 dog owners. The vaccinations comprised 111 first doses and 156 booster doses. Concurrently, the Majlis Perbandaran Padawan (MPP) issued 108 licenses and 105 microchips, alongside receiving 17 applications for neutering. In Serian, the event at Balai Raya Beratok saw the DVSS team vaccinate 74 dogs from 49 dog owners. This included 42 first doses and 32 booster doses. Licensing efforts by Majlis Daerah Serian (MDS) resulted in 45 dogs receiving both a license and a microchip.

KUCHING: The Sarawak State Legislative Assembly today passed the Veterinary Public Health (Amendment) Bill, 2022 to delegate the power of the Department of Veterinary Services (DVS) Sarawak in the fight against the spread of rabies.

State Food Industry, Commodity and Regional Development Minister Datuk Sri Dr Stephen Rundi Utom said apart from delegating functions and duties to any public officer, the bill seeks to allow the authorisation of other persons by DVS to dispense veterinary drugs.

He said the rabies outbreak in Sarawak started in 2017 when the first human case was reported in the Serian district and to date, a total of 72 areas in the state have been declared as rabies-infected areas.

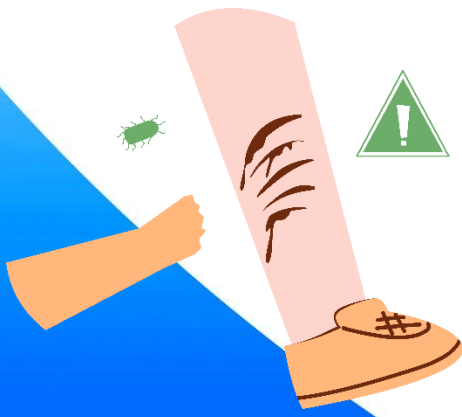

KUCHING: Sarawak has recorded its first human rabies infection for the year 2025, involving a stray cat bite this month, said Sarawak's Minister of Agricultural Modernization and Regional Development, Datuk Seri Dr Stephen Rundi Utom.

The first human rabies case in Sarawak for 2025 involves a 13-year-old teenager bitten by a stray cat; the victim is currently receiving treatment at Sarawak General Hospital. Authorities are actively controlling the stray animal population and advising the public to seek immediate medical attention if bitten, as rabies becomes difficult to cure once the virus reaches the brain.

The Rabies in Borneo Conference 2025 will be held from September 30 to October 1 in Kuching, with participation from Sabah, Kalimantan, Brunei, and other countries to discuss strategies for eradicating rabies in the region.

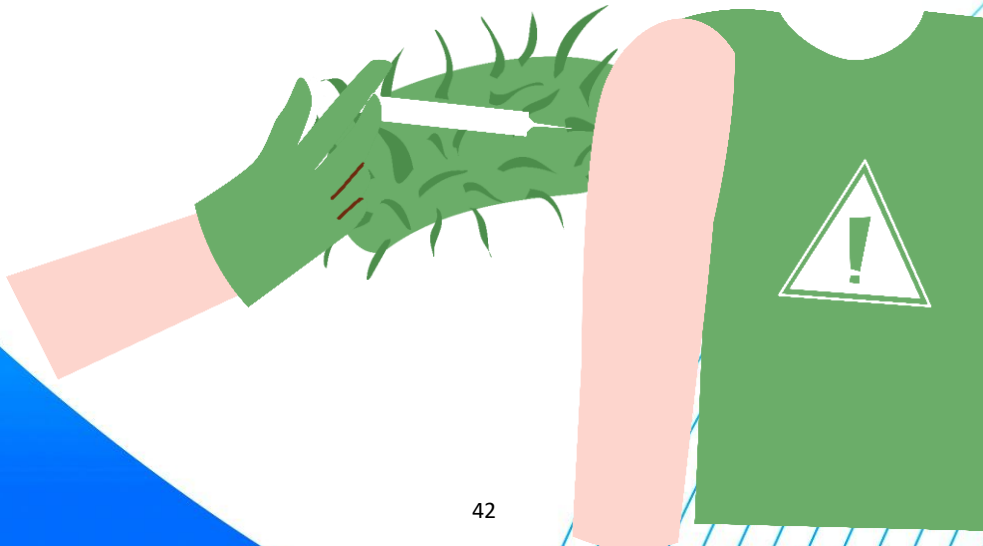

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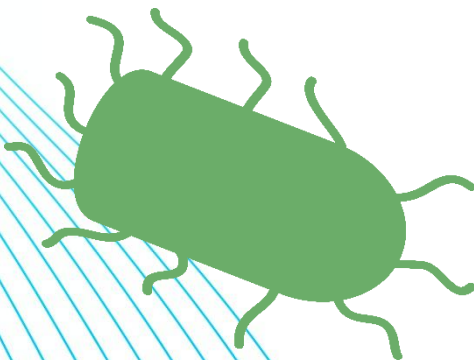

KUCHING (May 25): The Sarawak State Health Department has confirmed the first human rabies case in the state for 2025, involving a 13-year-old boy from Kampung Segedup, Kuching.

According to a statement posted by the department on its official Facebook page today, this is the first case recorded this year and marks a decrease of two cases compared to the same period in 2024.

The boy reportedly began exhibiting symptoms such as fever, loss of appetite, vomiting, hallucinations, delirium, difficulty walking, and trouble swallowing water on May 21.

He initially sought treatment at a private hospital before being referred to Sarawak General Hospital (SGH), where clinical tests confirmed the rabies infection.
